Khen Rinpoche Geshe Kachen Lobzang Tsetan is a Tibetan Buddhist monk from Ladakh, India who has been traveling and teaching in the United States for over thirty years. He began his monastic life at age seven in Stok, his family village in Ladakh, India. At age thirteen he joined the Stok Monastery to study and memorize Buddhist scriptures.

In 1995, Khen Rinpoche Geshe Kachen Lobzang Tsetan founded The Siddhartha School in his native home in Ladakh (www.siddharthaschool.org). The school seeks to preserve Tibetan Buddhist culture and language while giving the children of this remote Himalayan area a wellrounded education, which will allow them to represent themselves and their culture in this newly evolving global community.
